

City Ordinance No 12 Enacted
 "An Ordinance relating to Street
 Cropping and Cropswalks"

The City of Albany does Ordain as
 follows:

Section 1 That in all cases where streets in the city
 of Albany shall be ordered graded or gravelled
 by the owners of lots upon such streets, it
 shall be the duty of the person or persons
 owning corner lots to grade or gravel the
 streets in front of their respective lot fronts
 and to continue said grading or graveling
 to the center line of the street running
 at right angles with the street to be so
 graded or gravelled,

Section 2 This Ordinance shall apply to the
 streets ordered graded & gravelled by city
 ordinances No 5-6-7 &c passed by this
 Council for grading and graveling, Henry
 Lyon Ellsworth and Broad Albin streets
 and to all streets hereafter to be graded or
 gravelled.

Section 3 That hereafter when any side walk shall
 be ordered built or repaired by the owners
 of lots on any street it shall be the duty
 of the owners of corner lots to build or
 repair the cropswalks to the center line of
 the street running at right angles with
 the walk being built,

Section 4 That any Ordinance heretofore passed
 inconsistent with the provisions of this
 Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 5 That Section 4 of Chapter 6 Title 3 relating to
 Street cropping is hereby repealed.

City Ordinance No 12 continued

Sec 6 That when any crop walk in said city of Albany now built or hereafter to be built, becomes defective or out of order it shall be the duty of the lot holder on whose side of the street said crop walk is situated to proceed forthwith to repair the same after he is apprised of said defect. He shall be responsible for any damage that may result from such defect and upon the refusal of the lot owner to repair such crop walk it shall be the duty of the Marshal to proceed to repair the crop walk at the lot owners expense and to collect the cost of the same from said lot owner by an action before the recorder of said city.

Sec 7 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after five days from the date of its passage.
