

## Ordinance No 79

Amending Section three of Ordinance No Twelve.

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany -

That Section three of Ordinance Twelve be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows to wit -

Sec 3 The side walks on First Street from Calypso to Montgomery Streets shall be constructed as follows to wit.

To be ten feet wide to be laid on boards three by six inches six feet apart on five <sup>by</sup> stringers three by six inches and decked with planks to be two by six inches of ~~yellow~~ red or yellow fir and nailed to the stringers with twenty penny nails.

The cross walks on Canal Street shall be six feet wide of red or yellow fir three by six inches - to be laid on <sup>three</sup> boards two of which shall be four by six ~~inches~~ and eleven, three by six inches equally spaced, and oval in the center of three inches, and four inches higher in the center than at each end. Any stringer laid Section three in said Ordinance in conflict with this to be and the same is hereby repealed.
