An Ordinance Amending an Ordinance Entitled an ordinance regulating the Fire Department of the City of Albany

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany

Sec 1 That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 40 Entitled an Ordinance regulating the Fire Department of the City of Albany be amended so as to read as follows

Sec 2 There shall be an Election Annually on the first Tuesday in June for Chief Engineer and one Assistant Engineer said Election to be called by the President of the Department by giving ten days notice thereof in one of the Newspapers of the City The Board of Delegates Appoint to Conduct said Election three Judges from

The different Companies who shall subscribe to an oath or affirmation to faithfully discharge their duties; Said Election shall be held at such place as the Board of Fire Delegates may appoint and the polls for such an Election shall be opened at one O'clock P.M. and closed at 7 O'clock P.M. The voting shall be by ballot and immediately upon the closing of the Polls the vote shall be publicly counted and the returns of said Election duly certified shall be forwarded to the Secretary of the Fire Department within twenty four hours thereafter and be by him transmitted to the Board of Fire Delegates who shall convene within ten days thereafter and declare the result. The person having the highest number of votes for Chief Engineer shall be declared elected for the term of one year and until his successor is elected and qualified. The person having the highest number of votes for assistant Engineer shall be declared elected for the term of one year and until his successor is elected and qualified. Section 2. That Section 9 of the same Ordinance be amended so as to read as follows; Section 9. No person shall be allowed to vote at any Engineers Election unless he

The different Companies who shall subscribe to an oath or affirmation to faithfully discharge their duties; Said Election shall be held at such place as the Board of Fire Delegates may appoint and the polls for such an Election shall be opened at one O'clock P.M. and closed at 7 O'clock P.M. The voting shall be by ballot and immediately upon the closing of the Polls the vote shall be publicly counted and the returns of said Election duly certified shall be forwarded to the Secretary of the Fire Department within twenty four hours thereafter and be by him transmitted to the Board of Fire Delegates who shall convene within ten days thereafter and declare the result. The person having the highest number of votes for Chief Engineer shall be declared Elected for the term of one year and until his Successor is elected and qualified. The person having the highest number of votes for Assistant Engineer shall be declared elected for the term of one year and until his Successor is elected and qualified.

Section 2. That Section 9 of the same Ordinance be amended so as to read as follows;

Section 9. No person shall be allowed to vote at any Engineers Election unless he

shall have been a member of
the Department twenty five days
next preceding such Election
and no person shall be Eligible
to office in the Department without
possessing the qualifications of
a voter

An Ordinance for the preservation
of health and the prevention of disease

The City of Albany does Ordain
as follows

Sec 1 That any person or persons who
shall set up, open, lease to be
opened or keep any house or
place as a resort for the purpose
of smoking Opium or who
shall sell, barter, prepare or
deliver or permit to be sold
bartered prepared or delivered
for, or on his or their account
any Opium for the purpose
of being smoked upon the
premises shall be deemed
guilty of a Misdemeanor and
upon Conviction thereof before
the City Recorder shall be
punished by a fine not less
than five dollars nor more
