

## Ordinance 710-183.

An Ordinance to regulate the keeping of Cows or other cattle, and their running at large within the city limits.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section I. Each family may keep, and permit to run at large, within the city limits between the hours of six o'clock A.M. and nine o'clock P.M. of each day, two milk cows and no more, but between the hours of nine o'clock in the afternoon, and six o'clock in the forenoon, no cow or cattle of any kind shall be permitted to run at large within the corporate limits of the City of Albany; and any person owning or having the possession or control of any cow or cattle of any kind whatever, who shall permit or allow the same to run at large within the corporate limits of said city, except as hereinbefore provided, shall, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, be punished by a fine of not less than two dollars nor more than ten dollars, or by imprisonment in the City jail not less than one day nor more than five days, or both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the Court.

Section II. No person or persons shall suffer, permit or allow any cow or cows, calf or calves, or any cattle of any kind, owned by him or them, or in his or their possession, or under his or their control, to run at large within the corporate limits of the City of Albany at any hour of the day or night, except as provided in Section one of this ordinance; and any person, owning, controlling or having the possession of any cow or cows or cattle of any kind within the city limits shall keep the same at all times securely stabled or safely fastened upon his own premises, except as provided in Section one of this ordinance. Any person, who shall violate any of the provisions of this Section, shall, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court be punished by a fine of not less than two dollars, nor more than ten dollars, or by imprisonment in the City jail not less than one day nor more than five days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after ninety days after its approval by the Mayor, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions

of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

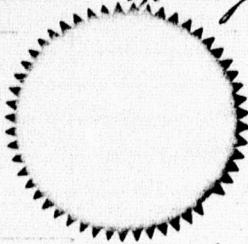
