

Ordinance No. 194.

An Ordinance relating to Cruelty to animals and Providing for the punishment thereof:

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That any person who shall cruelly beat, torture, misuse, deprive of food or water, or otherwise treat in a cruel manner any animal, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction before the Recorder Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than five, nor more than fifty dollars, or by imprisonment in the City jail not to exceed twenty five days.

Section 2. That, this Ordinance take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor
