An Ordinance to amend Section One of Ordinance Number 197. Entitled, "an Ordinance to establish the grade of Certain streets in the City of Albany." passed April 25th 1890, Approved April 29th 1890.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Amended as to Salem Road and Sherman St as set by Ordinance # 395 - Amended by Ord. 239

Section 1. That section one of Ordinance number 197, entitled, "an Ordinance to establish the grade of Certain streets in the City of Albany" passed April 25th 1890, approved April 29th 1890, be and is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. The established grade of the streets in the City of Albany, north of the Salem road, and extending from Main street, to the eastern boundary line of the City of Albany shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by City Surveyor, W. B. Barr in the year 1890, and now on file in the Office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, save and except, that the established grade of Water street and of Front street, from the east line of main street to the west line of Pine street, and of Sherman street and Oak street from First street to Willamette street shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by City Surveyor W. B. Barr in the year 1891, and now on file in the Office of the Recorder of the City of Albany.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
