

Ordinance 234.

An Ordinance, authorizing and directing the Mayor of the City of Albany to enter into and sign a contract in writing on behalf of said City with Frank J. Miller thereby employing said Miller to superintend, for said City the construction of the high, steel wagon bridge now being constructed by the City across the Willamette River at the northern terminus of Calapooia street in said City

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the City of Albany be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into and sign a contract in writing on behalf of said City with Frank J. Miller, thereby employing said Miller to superintend for said City the construction of the steel wagon bridge now being constructed by the City across the Willamette River from the northern terminus of Calapooia street, and to bind said City in such contract to pay said Miller the sum of thirteen Hundred, and fifty dollars and no more therefor.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.

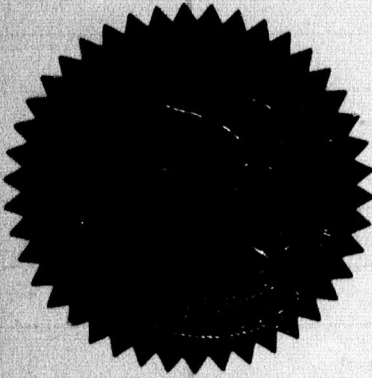
