

ORDINANCE NO. 343

Ord. No 345 An Ordinance to provide for the repairing of the Steel Bridge across the Willamette River belonging to the City of Albany, and for the appropriation of money therefor.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-

Section I. That the Committee on streets and public property be and they are hereby authorized and directed to cause to be repaired the Steel Bridge belonging to the City that spans the Willamette river, by placing the same in good order and condition for travel; by redecking, repiling, where necessary repainting, if necessary and to make any and all improvements that may be necessary to place said bridge in good order and condition, and that there be and is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the City, the sum of \$4000⁰⁰.00 so much thereof as is necessary for that purpose.

Section II. That said committee on streets and public property be and they are hereby authorized, without giving public notice or otherwise advertising or receiving bids therefor, to enter into any and all contracts that may be necessary for the purchase of material to be used in the repair of said bridge, as mentioned in Section one, and to employ such superintendents, mechanics and laborers as may be necessary to do the work of repairing said bridge, as expeditiously as possible.

Section III. That said committee shall cause said work of repairing to be commenced immediately and carried to completion as early as practicable.

Section IV. This ordinance to be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.

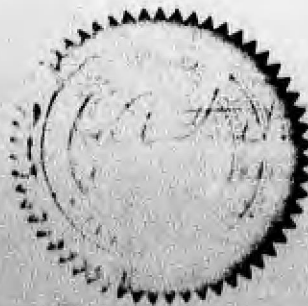
