Ord. 360 An Ordinance appropriating the sum of \$226.19 and payment for a heater for the fire engine Company No. 2 of the Albany Fire Department.
passed by the Council of the City of Albany Oregon
Dec 24, 1901

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:
Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund of the City of Albany Oregon, in the hands of the Treasurer of said City, the sum of Two hundred twenty six and 19/100 Dollars (\$226.19) to be applied to the payment of the cost and expense of a heater for the fire engine installed at the engine house of Fire Engine Company No. 2, of the Fire Department of said City, and the Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to issue a warrant for said sum payable to A. G. Long, as payment to be applied as aforesaid.
Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
