

## ORDINANCE NO. 393

An ordinance authorizing the building laying and construction of a wooden sidewalk six feet in width on the West side of Main Street adjoining the East line of the South East quarter of Block No. 129 in Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany Oregon; Also on the North side of Second Street adjoining the South line of said South East quarter of said block No. 129; Also on the North side of the Salem Road adjoining the South line of Block No. 6. in Hackleman's Third Addition to the said City. And to authorize the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany to enter into a contract on the part of said City for the construction of the same and providing for the costs and expenses of the building, laying and construction of said sidewalk to be assessed to the owners and holders of said lots and parts of lots, and become a lien upon said lots and parts of lots abutting on and adjoining said sidewalk for the payment of the costs of construction, and matters kindred thereto.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows: —

Sec. 1. That there shall be constructed a wooden sidewalk six feet in width on the West side of Main Street adjoining the East line of the South East quarter of Block No. 129 in Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany Oregon; Also on the North side of Second Street adjoining the South line of said Southeast quarter of said Block No. 129. Also on the North line of the Salem Road adjoining the South line of Block No. 6. in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, at the cost and expense of the owners and holders of said real property and that the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany be and they are hereby directed and empowered to enter into and sign on on behalf of the City of Albany written articles of agreement for the construction and laying of a sidewalk six feet in width abutting and adjoining said lots and parts of lots as above set forth; Provided that said contract shall not be entered into and said articles of agreement signed by the Mayor and Recorder on the part of the City until offers proposals for the construction of said sidewalk have been advertised for in the manner provided for by the city charter and ordinances regulating the awarding of all contracts and bids have been received and considered by the council and the contract awarded by the council and the costs and expenses of constructing the same shall have been ascertained

fixed and determined.  
Section 2: - That the costs and expenses of the construction of said sidewalks shall be made a lien upon the property adjacent to which the same is constructed, to be created and enforced in the manner provided for by the charter and ordinances of said city.

Sec. 3: - This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
