An Ordinance requiring the Portland, Eugene & Eastern Railway Company, its successors or assigns to remove the planking along the side of the street-car track on First Street and Lyon Street in Albany, Oregon and to pave said space with the best quality of vitrified paving brick.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Portland, Eugene & Eastern Railway Company, its successors or assigns of the franchise granted by Ordinance No. 478 of the City of Albany are hereby required on or before June 1<sup>st</sup>, 1912 to remove all planking along the track of the street-car line on First Street and Lyon Street in said City of Albany, Oregon and to pave the space now occupied by said planking with the best quality of vitrified paving brick, laid on a concrete base with sand cushion, laid in a proper and workmanlike manner to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Streets of said City of Albany.

Section 2. Whereas existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency exists and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
