

ORDINANCE NO. 666

An ordinance fixing the time and place of regular meetings of the Council under the charter of the Mayor and Council and repealing Ordinance No. 137 entitled "An ordinance relating to the meetings, powers and compensations of the city council" passed August 18, 1885, approved August 25, 1885;

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That the regular meetings of the council shall be held on the second and fourth weeks of each month at the council chambers as now located or hereafter located and it may adjourn to the next succeeding regular meeting or to some specified time prior thereto.

Section 2. The Mayor and councilman shall each be allowed the sum of \$1.00 for each meeting of the council attended to be paid quarterly as other claims against the city.

Section 3. That ordinance No. 137 entitled "An ordinance relating to the meetings, powers and compensations of the city council" passed August 18, 1885, approved August 25, 1885, is hereby repealed.
