An ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined in Resolution No. 25, adopted by said council on the 11th day of June, 1913, to make on Sixth Street from the West line of Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street, to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said Sixth Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Sixth Street to be so improved; to direct the recorder of said city to enter a statement of such assessment in the blocks of City liens as provided by the charter of said city.

Whereas, on the 14th day of May, 1913, the council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said city to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Sixth Street from the West line of Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street in said city by grading said street to the required subgrade and grading said street six inches deep in the center and three inches deep at the outer edges, twelve feet wide, and for the estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Sixth Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in Recorder's office of said city, said resolution being entitled "Resolution No. 18" and adopted the 14th day of May, 1913; and

Whereas, the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said resolution No. 18 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for the improvement of said Sixth Street in the manner specified in said resolution No. 18 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office in said city on the 28th day of May, 1913; and

Whereas, the said city council on the 11th day of June, 1913, by resolution No. 25, duly adopted by said council determined and resolved that it deemed it inexpedient and that said council proposed to improve Sixth Street from the West line of Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 25; and

Whereas, in and by said resolution No. 25 adopted as aforesaid by the council, the Recorder of said city was duly selected and directed by said council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Sixth Street from the West line of Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street as provided by the Charter of said City of Albany; and

Whereas, the City Recorder, in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Sixth Street in the manner provided by the charter of said city, and

Whereas, the said council in and by said resolution No. 25 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Sixth Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Sixth Street to be improved as mentioned in said Resolution No. 25 to be the sum of \$228.02.

Therefore,

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Sixth Street in the City of Albany, beginning from the West line of Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street shall be improved as follows:

First. By grading said street to the required subgrade.

Second. By graveling said street six inches deep in the center and three inches deep at the outer edges, twelve feet wide.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 25 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the City Recorder of said City of Albany on the 28th day of May, 1913.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvements of said Sixth Street in the City of Albany, beginning from the West line of Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street in the manner herebefore determined by the council of the said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 25 is hereby declared to be the sum of \$228.02.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvements of said Sixth Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Sixth Street to be improved as above said and as determined in said council in and by said Resolution No. 25 is hereby asserted and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
