

Ord 675

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with A. W. Hockstader for the improvement of Sixth Street from the West line of Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street.

Whereas by Resolution No. 25 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the council on the 17th day of June, 1913, it was ordered that the following streets in the City of Albany, to-wit: Sixth Street from the West line of Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street be improved in the following manner:

- First: By grading said street to the required sub grade.  
 Second: By graveling said street six inches deep in the center and three inches deep at the outer edges, twelve feet wide.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the City Recorder of the City of Albany, Ark.

Whereas, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the City Recorder of said city, according to law and the resolution last aforesaid, to-wit: On the 27th day of August, 1913, A. W. Hockstader presented to the council of said city his bid for making said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the council, by which said bid said A. W. Hockstader proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the sum of \$217.50 and

Whereas, said bid was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the best and best for

the People of the City of Albany be bid in as follows:

Section 1. That the said bid of the said A. W. Hockstader for said improvement of said Sixth Street is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said city are authorized

to enter into a contract in writing with the said W. W. Bockstader for the making of said improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid and the agreement hereinbefore mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that work of said improvement shall commence within five days after the signing of said contract and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 15th day of September, 1913, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be liable to receive damages to the extent of \$5.00 per day, after said time, if the work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that said W. W. Bockstader furnish a bond in the sum of One Hundred Dollars to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, as condition for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the said W. W. Bockstader and further indemnify the City of Albany against any claim or suit for labor, work or materials on the part of any person arising out of such contract.
