Ord 676

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with G. W. Foster and for the City to purchase Hill Street from the North curb line of First Street to the North curb line of Third Street. Whereas a Resolution No. 22 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed on the 22nd day of July, 1915, it was ordered that the City of Albany, Oregon, to purchase Hill Street from the North curb line of First Street to the North curb line of Third Street in the following manner:

To wit: by widening said street to the required sub grade. Records of the records of the street six inches deep at the corners and the same in place deep at the meter edges, in the same width.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the City Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon.

Whereas, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids on the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the City Recorder of said city according to law and the resolution last aforesaid, to-wit: on the 27th day of August, 1915, G. W. Foster presented to the Council of said city a bid for making said improvement, which bid was made in accordance with the conditions, with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, of which said bid said G. W. Foster was not only a guarantor and implementer and performer of the same, necessary to make the same legal in payment for the same. It is, therefore,

Whereas, said bid was the lowest bid for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best

Therefore:

The People of the City of Albany do sustain as follows:

That the said bid of G. W. Foster is the lowest and best bid for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best

the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said city are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said A. W. [unreadable] contractor for [unreadable] said improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid and the agreement hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that work of said improvement shall commence within fifteen days after the signing of said contract and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 1st day of October, 1913, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$5.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time; and that said A. W. [unreadable] contractor shall pay in the sum of two hundred dollars to be applied by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the said A. W. [unreadable] contractor and further indemnify the City of Albany against any claim or liability for work or materials on the part of any person arising out of said contract.
