An ordinance to regulate the fire department of the City of Albany and repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict therewith.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. The fire department of the City of Albany shall consist of a chief engineer, an assistant engineer, one engine man, one auto driver and two men. City treasurer shall drive engine.

Section 2. The members of the Fire department shall annually on the first Monday of January elect a chief engineer and one assistant engineer. Such election shall be certified by the chief engineer of the fire department to the council and the council by majority vote shall either confirm or disapprove said election and in case of disapproval by a majority of the council, the fire department shall upon the date to be fixed by the council by resolution, elect another chief engineer and assistant engineer and the same shall be reported to the council and a majority of the council shall confirm or disapprove such election and so on until a chief engineer and assistant engineer shall be elected by the department that shall be confirmed by a majority of the council.

Section 3. The chief engineer and the assistant engineer shall hold their respective offices until their successors are elected and qualified or the council may at any time by a two-thirds vote declare the office of chief engineer or assistant engineer vacant. Whenever there is a vacancy in the office of chief engineer or assistant engineer, the council shall by a majority vote appoint some qualified person to act until a successor be so appointed as provided in Section two of this Ordinance.

Section 4. The chief engineer and assistant engineer before entering upon the duties of their respective offices, shall each subscribe an oath or affirmation to faithfully and to the best of his ability perform the duties of his office.

Section 5. The chief engineer shall receive two annual salary of \$250.00 commencing on the first day of the month of the same as other claims against the city are paid, provided that in and the chief engineer shall subscribe an affidavit during his term of office during the time of such a salary shall be paid to the assistant engineer as other claims against the city and shall be deducted from the salary of the chief engineer. The salary of the engine man shall be \$70.00 per month, payable monthly out of the city treasury as other claims are paid. The salary of the auto driver shall be \$60.00 per month payable monthly as other claims against the City are paid.

salary of the assistant engineer and the six firemen, all to \$10.00 per month payable quarterly as other claims against the city are paid.

Section 6. The engine man and auto driver shall be up and duty at all times and shall lodge within the department headquarters. The assistant engineer, the City Teamster and the six firemen shall lodge within the headquarters and shall be subject to call at all times. The council shall by a majority vote appoint the engine man and driver and six firemen, who shall serve during the pleasure of the council.

Section 7. The chief engineer shall within five days after any fire, make report in writing to the council, stating the cause, if known, a description of the property destroyed or injured, and a report of the cause thereof, the estimated loss and whether the property was insured, and if so in what amount. The chief engineer shall report to the council in writing at its last meeting in December each year and whenever required, the number, location and condition of all districts and fire apparatus and the state and condition of the department headquarters and all property of the city in the custody and keeping of the department with such recommendations as the council may deem proper. The chief engineer shall investigate the cause of fires and cause complaints to be filed against and diligently prosecute all persons criminally connected therewith.

Section 8. If any person elected to the office of chief engineer or assistant engineer or fireman, shall refuse to qualify or refuse to qualify as required within the time specified in the rate of this ordinance or if appointed, the office shall remain vacant.

Section 9. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 10. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby made a part of the ordinance and shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
