

ORDINANCE NO. 714th 1906

An ordinance to amend section 3 of Ordinance No. 68 of the City of Albany, entitled "An ordinance granting unto H. H. Allen, his successors or assigns, the right to erect and maintain a system of electric lights and telephones in the City of Albany, New York", passed by the Council October 20, 1887, approved by the Mayor November 3, 1887.

The People of the City of Albany do hereby enact and ordain:

Section 1. That section 3 of Ordinance No. 68 of the City of Albany, entitled "An ordinance granting unto H. H. Allen, his successors or assigns, the right to erect and maintain a system of electric lights and telephones in the City of Albany, New York", passed by the Council October 20, 1887, approved by the Mayor November 3, 1887, be and the same is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

Section 3. Whenever it shall become necessary in the erection of any wires, posts, poles or towers, to interfere in any manner with any other town, city, village, or corporation, and any roads, sidewalks, streets, or any other public or private property, or to cause any obstruction or other material injury, such as to block up or interfere with the passage of any vehicle, or to cause any other material injury, such as to block up or interfere with the passage of any vehicle, or to cause any other material injury, such as to block up or interfere with the passage of any vehicle, this ordinance shall not be held to apply.
