

## ORDINANCE NO. 715.

Ord. 715

RECORDED ALBANY, OREGON

A. Ordinance authorizing the purchase of a team  
of gray percheron horses five years old, from J. C. Harlan  
and partaking in the payment therefor.

Whereas the City of Albany is without a team of horses, and  
Whereas J. C. Harlan has offered to sell to the City of Albany  
a team of gray percheron horses five years old for the sum of  
\$350.00; and!

Whereas the City of Albany has sold the team to the City  
of Albany for the sum of \$300.00, which amount of \$300.00  
is now payable in the streets and of the City of Albany;

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Action 1. That the City of Albany hereby agrees to purchase  
of J. C. Harlan for the sum of \$350.00, one team of gray per-  
cheron horses five years old, at the sum of \$350.00, and in payment  
therefor there shall be issued a warrant on the street fund for the  
sum of \$350.00 payable to the said J. C. Harlan and delivered  
by the superintendent of Streets to the said J. C. Harlan  
and the said sum so agreed to be purchased shall be deliv-  
ered to the City of Albany.
