Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 741 of the City of Albany, entitled "An ordinance declaring it unlawful for any person or persons, firm or corporation to keep trees or stands of trees within the limits of the City of Albany and providing a punishment for such offense" passed by the Council of the City of Albany on March 25, 1914, and approved March 26, 1914.

The People of the City of Albany do hereby enact as follows:

Section 1.
