

An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer beginning at its manhole in Oak Street being sewer, midway between Seventh and Eighth Streets, and running thence easterly across Block 1, across Pine Street, and 168 feet into Block 2, all in Hackleman's Woodland Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, providing nevertheless that no improvements shall be paid, the property owner in said City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement if the same is not completed within the time agreed upon, and the person or persons making such improvement shall be held to a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work and improvements, and providing for the completion of said City, in case of proper notice for bids for the completion of said improvements.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an eight inch vitrified terra cotta sewer beginning at its manhole in Oak Street being sewer, midway between Seventh and Eighth Streets, and running thence easterly across Block 1, across Pine Street, and 168 feet into Block 2, all in Hackleman's Woodland Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon.

Said improvements shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinance of the City of Albany, Oregon, and plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer, said City, for the construction of said sewer shall be filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 8th day of April, 1914.

The cost of said lateral sewer shall be paid out of the moneys collected and arising out of the assessments to be made, ascertained and declared by ordinance on the lots and parcels of lots adjacent to said improvements so to be made and especially and particularly benefited thereby as provided by the charter of said city.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of July, 1915.

Bids for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall make and contract to make shall be held to be the city, or the making of said improvement shall be held commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract make, execute and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient security to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in the sum of \$1,000.00 for the faithful performance of said contract.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any

contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 9. The Recorder of said city is hereby directed to immediately give proper notice for and to the making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Herald and Journal, a daily newspaper published in said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
