

Any Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Pine Street from the south line of Dolan Road to the north line of Chantane Road, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work & such improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for bids for the completion of said improvement of said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That Pine Street from the south line of Dolan Road to the north line of Chantane Road shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the required grade and subgrade.

Second: By grading said street six inches deep and eight feet wide.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City for the improvement of said street filed in the office of the Recorder of said City in Albany, Oregon, on the 12th day of May, 1900, endorsed "Engineer's plans and specifications for the improvement of Pine Street from Dolan Road to Chantane Road, and the estimate of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of Pine Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising above and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the vote and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said Pine Street to be improved, and especially and particularly benefited thereby as provided by the charter of said City.

The said improvement of said portion of said Pine Street shall be completed by the 1st day of August, 1900.

All bids in the making of said improvement of said street deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Pine Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said City shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$5.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor during the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of Pine Street by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily News, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Pine Street.
