

ORDINANCE No. 352

AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON HAS DETERMINED IN RESOLUTION NO. 27 ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 11TH DAY OF AUGUST 1915 TO MAKE ON FIRST STREET FROM THE EAST LINE OF MAIN STREET TO THE WEST CURB LINE OF SHERMAN STREET; TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECIDE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID FIRST STREET THAT IS ASSESSED UPON EACH LOT OR PART THEREOF ADJACENT TO SAID PART OF SAID FIRST STREET TO BE SO IMPROVED; TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS on the 28th day of July, 1915 the council of the city of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of First Street from the East line of Main Street to the west curb line of Sherman Street in the following manner to-wit:-

First. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.

Second. By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections, with asphalt concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.

Third. By laying and construction asphaltic concrete headings.

Fourth. By constructing catch basins.

Fifth. By constructing inlets.

Sixth. By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

and for estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of First Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates, and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No. 24" and adopted the 28th day of July 1915.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said resolution No. 24 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said First Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 24 and filed plans, specifications and estimates in the recorder's office in said City on the 19th day of August 1915.

WHEREAS the council on the 11th day of August 1915 by Resolution No. 27 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve First Street from the East line of Main Street to the West curb line of Sherman Street in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 27; and WHEREAS, in and by said Resolution No. 27 adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said First Street from the East line of Main Street to the West curb line of Sherman Street as provided by the Charter of said City; and

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WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said First Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City; and

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by the said Resolution No. 27 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said First Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said First Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 27 to be the sum of \$1537.73.

## T H E R E F O R E

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That First Street in the City of Albany, Oregon from the East line of Main Street to the West curb line of Sherman Street shall be improved as follows:

- First. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second. By paving the roadway of said street full width with asphalt intersections, with asphalt concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third. By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete headings.
- Fourth. By constructing catch basins.
- Fifth. By constructing inlets.
- Sixth. By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 27 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 19th day of August 1915.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said First Street in the City of Albany from the East line of Main Street to the West curb line of Sherman Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of Albany in and by Resolution No. 27 with asphaltic concrete pavement to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said First Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$1537.73.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said First Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of First Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 27 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:

Lot 7 in Block 3 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, 66 feet on First Street, Assessed at \$192.22.

Edna B. Warner.

Lot 6 in Block 3 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, 66 feet on First Street, Assessed at \$192.22.

J. A. Wood.

Lot 5 in Block 3 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, 66 feet on First Street, Assessed at \$192.22.

H. G. Hastings and I. A. Hastings.

Lot 3 in Block 4 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, 66 feet on First Street, Assessed at 192.22.

Isaac Knotts.

Lot 4 in Block 4 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, 66 feet on First Street, Assessed at \$ 192.22.

W. A. and Anna S Harpe.

Lots 1 and 2 in Block 4 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, 132 feet on First Street, Assessed at \$334.44.

Section 4. That the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessments made and declared by this ordinance together with the names of the respective owners of such lots or parts thereof hereinabove described in the Docket of the City Leins of the said City of Albany, Oregon as provided in the Charter of said City.
