# ORDINANCE NO. 990

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO HAVE IN POSSESSION ANY SPIRITOUS, MALT, VINOUS OR OTHER INTOXICATING LIQUORS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That from and after the taking effect of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation either as owner, agent or otherwise to have in possession or under his control in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, any spiritous, vinous, malt or other intoxicating liquors unless said possession or control be lawful as provided by the laws of the State of Oregon.

Section 2. Any firm, person or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court in and for said City be punished by a fine of not less than Five dollars or by imprisonment in the City jail for a period of not less than three days or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Recorder.

WHEREAS this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
