AN ORDINANCE ANNUATING THANK TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND PROVIDING A PROMITY FOR VIOLATION THREEDS.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALMATY DO GEDALE AS POLLING:

Section 1. For the purposes of this ordinances the term "vehicle" used herein is defined to include all movable things except street and interurban mars, and the term "motor vehicles" used herein is hereby defined to include all vehicles propelled by any power other than muscular power.

fire hydrant in the city of Albany or so as to obstruct any street crossing for pedestrians. I parked motor vehicle shall be placed with the rear right-hand wheel not
more than eight inches from the curboni the front right hand wheel not more than seven
feet from the durb.

direction 3. A motor vehicle overtaking any other vehicle travalling in the same direction, before narsing the same shall give a signal by one blast or stroke of a horn, bell, whistle, rong or other signalling device, and the driver of any motor vehicle about to turn either from a standatill or while in motion, shall give timely signal by outstretched hand or in some other unmistakeble manner, indicate the direction of the turn. The driver of a notor vehicle, before backing, shall give warning by three blasts of a horn, bell, whistle, gong or other signalling device, and in stopping shall give timely warning to those behind by signalling with the hand or in some other unmistakable manner indicating the intention to sto. No motor vehicle shall overable any other vehicle travelling in the same direction upon street intersections.

Sention 4. To orientor of any motor vehicle shall use any nectylene, electric or other head light unless it shall be so shded as not to blind or dazzle other users of the highway or make it difficult or unsafe for them to ride, drive or walk thereon. The head lights of every motor vehicle shall be dapable of throwing sufficient light shead to reveal any person, vehicle or substantial object upon the roadway straight about of such notor vehicle at a distance of at least one hundred (100) feet.

Section 5. No person shall ride or trespass upon any vehicle without the consent of the driver, nor shall any person riding upon any vehicle, sled or other conveyance nitch or hold on to any part of any other vehicle, street or interurban car with or without the consent of the driver thereof.

Section 6. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof before the accordance Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more that \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the City Tail for not less than five nor more than ten days.
