

# ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 1, 2, AND 3 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 173 OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF DANGEROUS OR CONTAGIOUS DISEASES", PASSED BY THE COUNCIL, FEBRUARY 14TH, 1888 AND APPROVED FEBRUARY 16TH, 1888.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Sections 1, 2 and 3 of ordinance number 173 of the City of Albany, Oregon, entitled, "An ordinance to protect the public health and to prevent the spread of dangerous or contagious diseases", passed by the Council February 14th, 1888, and approved February 16th, 1888, be and the same are hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Albany shall during the month of January of each year elect a physician of skill and experience who shall be Health Officer of the City of Albany, Oregon, and member of the Board of Health of said City, whose term of office shall continue until the first day of January next following the date of his appointment or until his successor shall be appointed and qualified. The Board of Health of the City of Albany, Oregon shall consist of the Mayor, Chairman of the Committee on Health and Police, City Health Officer and City Marshall.

Section 2. The Health Officer of the City of Albany shall keep in his office a book in which shall be entered the name and place of residence of any person who is affected with any of the diseases hereinafter mentioned in this ordinance and it shall be his duty to visit and examine persons sick with any infectious or contagious disease, to certify to the cause of death of any person and to advise the Board of Health in any matter relating to the health of the City. The Health Officer shall receive such compensation as the Council may consider reasonable.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the Marshall to execute the orders and enforce the regulations of the Board of Health and of the Health Officer.
