ORDINANCE NO. 962.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH W. S. WEAVER FOR THE BUILD-ING AND CONSTRUCTING OF A LATERAL SEWER SEGULTING AT A MAUHOLE TO SE CONSTRUCTION OF THE RAILROAD STREET TRUNK SEWER KIDWAY BETWEEN SECOND AND THIRD STREET TRUNK SEWER KIDWAY BETWEEN SECOND AND THIRD STREET, OR SO CUCH OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OR SOON, A DISTANCE OF STORY PRET, OR SO CUCH OF THE PRESENT LATERAL SEWER IN PLACE AS SHALL BE FOUND THE TERIORATED TO THE EXTENT THAT IT DEEDS REPLACEMENT BY LAYING AN RIGHT INCH VITHIFIED TERRA COTTA SEWER PIPE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS AND SHECIFYCA-TIONS OF ENGLISHER JOHN R. FRILLAND FOR SAID LATERAL SEWER FILED IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORECON, ON FRENUARY 11, 1920.

WHEREAS, BY RESOLUTION NO. 15, FASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY ON THE 25th Day of Fubruary, 1920, it was dedered that the above the scribed lateral sever be constructed, said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the city of albany and the plane, specifications and astimates of the city engineer them on file with the accorder of the city of albany; and

WHEREAS, AFTER DUE NOTICE AND ADVERTISHIENT FOR BIDS MADE AND SIVEN BY THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY ACCORDING TO SAID CROTHLOCK. IN THE 24th DAY OF MARCH, 1920, W. S. VEAVER PRESENTED TO THE COMMONLOCK. IN CITY HIBS FOR MAKING SAID IMPROVEMENT, WHICH BID WAS MADE IN DUE FORM MADE IN COMFORMITY WITH ALL THE CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY LAW AND BY SAID CROTMANGE, BY WHICH SAID BID SAID W. S. WEAVER IROPOSED TO FURNISH ALL INTERIAL AND MADE PLEIGHTS AND PREFERRI THE LABOR MECRESARY TO MAKE THE ABOVE DESCRIBED IN-PROVEMENT FOR THE SUM OF \$2105.40; AND

WHEREAS, W. S. WEAVER WAS THE LOWEST BIJDER FOR SAID PROPOSED YORK, AND SAID BID WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID THEREFOR.

THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the said bid of said W. S. Weaver for said improvement, be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said W. S. Weaver for the making of soid improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms and conditions in said ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinabove mentioned. Said contract shall provide that the work on said sewer shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work emeraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 15th day of June, 1920, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the entent of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time.

Said contract shall further provide that the said W. S. Weaver shall promptly, as due, make payment to all persons supplying to the said W. S. Weaver labor or material for the prosecution of the hereinabove described work and that the said W. S. Weaver shall not peimit any lien or claim to be filed or prosecuted against the City of Albany for or on account of any material or labor furnished for the said work.

The said W. S. Wenver shall furnish a penal bond in the sum of \$1000.00, with good and sufficient surety, to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of said contract on the part of said W. S. Wenver and particularly against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any
