

ORDINANCE NO. 995

AN ORDINANCE TO ASCERTAIN, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE COST OF REBUILDING A SIDEWALK ALONG THE EAST ONE HALF ($E\frac{1}{2}$) OF THE NORTHEAST ONE FOURTH ($N.E.\frac{1}{4}$) OF BLOCK NO. 37 IN HACKLEMAN'S SECOND ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON; TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT THAT IS ASSESSED UPON EACH LOT OR PART THEREOF ABUTTING THE SAID PROPERTY ABOVE DESCRIBED; TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LISTS AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of March 1931, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Albany, Oregon, reported in writing to the Council of the City of Albany Oregon that a sidewalk should be rebuilt along the East one half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the North east one fourth ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Block No. 37 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, which said report is on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon.

WHEREAS, thereafter the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted Resolution No. 8 and in and by said Resolution deemed it expedient and necessary that said sidewalk should be rebuilt, and said Resolution required Carl Schnuerstein, Sr. the reputed owner of said property to rebuild a sidewalk on the South side of Third Street along the North line of the East one half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the North-east one fourth ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Block No. 37 to the City of Albany, Oregon and that said sidewalk be rebuilt within thirty days from the adoption of said Resolution.

WHEREAS, the said Carl Schnuerstein Sr. was duly and regularly notified as required by the Charter and Ordinances of said City of Albany, of the adoption of said Resolution No. 8 and further notified that in the event he failed to rebuild said sidewalk within thirty days that the City of Albany would cause the same to be constructed and assess the cost thereof against the real property abutting there on.

WHEREAS, the said Carl Schnuerstein, Sr. did fail, neglect and refuse to rebuild or cause to be rebuilt said sidewalk or any part thereof, within the time and manner required by Resolution No. 8.

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets in and for the City of Albany, Oregon, after the expiration of the period of thirty days, as provided by said Resolution No. 8 did proceed to construct said sidewalk and has reported to the Council that said sidewalk has been constructed; that he has also submitted a full, complete and detailed report of the cost of construction of said sidewalk and the whole thereof.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon in and by Resolution No. 21 duly adopted by the Council of the City of Albany on the 22nd day of June, 1931 in which said Resolution the amount of \$ 92.20, the cost of the construction of said sidewalk was determined and declared to be a reasonable and just cost of construction of said sidewalk; and

WHEREAS, the report of said Superintendent of Streets of the City of Albany, Oregon was duly approved and by said Resolution No. 21.

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THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY OREGON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the cost of rebuilding a sidewalk along the East one half (E 1/2) of the Northeast one fourth (NE 1/4) of Block No. 37 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City Of Albany, Oregon be and the same is hereby ascertained, declared and determined to be the sum of \$ 92.20.

Section 2. that the proportionate share of said cost of the construction of said sidewalk assessed upon each lot or part thereof, as aforesaid as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 21 is hereby ascertained, determined and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the description as follows:

Carl Schnuerstein, Sr. the East one half (E 1/2) of the Northeast one fourth (NE 1/4) of Block No. 37 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, assessed at \$ 92.20/

Section 3. That the Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessment made and declared by this Ordinance, together with the name of the respective owner of the lot herein above described in the Docket of City Liens of the City of Albany, Oregon, as provided in the Charter of said City.
