A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE To amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 573 passed by the Council on the 20th. day of March, 1912 and approved by the Mayor an the 23rd. day of March, 1912, and entitled "An Ordinance regulating the use of demmercial or delivery tricycles, bicycles and tricycles within the City of Albany and providing a penalty for the violation thereof".

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 573 of the City of Albany, Oregon entitled "An ordinance regulating the use of commercial or delivery tricycles, bicycles and tricycles within the City of Albany and providing a penalty for the violation thereof", passed by the Council on the 20th, day of March, 1912 and approved by the Mayor on the 23rd. day of March, 1912 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride or operate any commercial or delivery tricycle or bicycle upon any sidewalk within the City of Albany, or to ride or operate any tricycle or bicycle whatsoever upon any sidewalk leading to, or on any platform surrounding any railway station situated within the City of Albany.
