

ORDINANCE No. 1165

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of Eight Hundred Three and 25-100 Dollars (\$803.25) for the purchase of one Ford Truck.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of Eight Hundred Three and 25-100 Dollars ~~(\$803.25)~~ (\$803.25) for the purpose of purchasing one new Ford Truck with Buckstell axle and Martin Parry steel body from the Kirk-Pollak Motor Company of Albany, Oregon.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant upon the Treasurer of said City against the general fund in the sum of Eight Hundred Three and 25-100 Dollars (\$803.25) Payable to Kirk-Pollak Motor Company in payment of said truck.
