ORDINANCE No. 1176

AN ORDINANCE to regulate the parking of motor vehicles within the City of Albany, Oregon, and to provide a penalty for violation hereof.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to leave any motor vehicle parked and unattended upon any Street, alley, or public thoroughfare within the City of Albany, Oregon, for more than one hour at a time, between the hours of 12 o'clock midnight and 4 o'clock A.M. of any day within the following described portion of said City, to-wit: On Water Street, First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street and Fifth Street, on and between Calapooia Street and Railroad Street, and all intervening streets and alleys within said described district.

Section 2. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$1.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not less than one day, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
