

ORDINANCE No. 1219

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$347.96 of the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, to pay the cost of making certain repairs of main sewer of said City, and declaring an emergency.

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated of the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of Three Hundred Forty Seven and 96/100 Dollars (\$347.96) to pay the cost of making certain repairs and extension on Calapooia Street main sewer of said City, by W.S. Weaver, and the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant upon the general fund of said City, payable to W.S. Weaver, in the sum hereby appropriated.

Section 2. That, WHEREAS, the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
