## ORDINANCE NO. 1252

AN ORDINANCE to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined to make in Resolution No. 11, adopted by said Council on the 27th day of April, 1927, on Righth Street, in said City, from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin Street, and from the west line of Broadalbin Street to the east line of Ferry Street, except a strip 36 feet wide, being 18 feet on each side of the center line of Righth Street, and extending the full length of the improvement; to ascertain, assess, determing and declare the proportionate share of such pubble cost of such improvement of Righth Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said portion of Eighth Street to be improved; to authorize and direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of April, 1927, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring Charles H. Leonard, Engineer, to prepare and file in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 27th day of April, 1927, plans, specifications and estimates of the probable cost of making the imprevement of Righth Street in said City, from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin Street and from the west line of Broadalbin Street to the east line of Ferry Street with a suitable hard surface pavement to be

WHEREAS, in and by said Resolution No. 11, adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Eighth Street from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin Street, and from the west line of "road-albin Street to the east line of Ferry Street, as provided by the charter and or-

WHERRAS, the Recorder, in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany, did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Eighth Street in the manner provided by said resolution and the charter

Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1251, after due notice for the time and in the manner provided by law the bid of W.W. Head Construction Co. for the making of said improvement of said portion of Eighth Street was accepted and the Hayor and Recorder of the City of Albany were thereby authorized to enter into a contract with W.W. Head Construction Co. for the making of said improvement in accordance with said bid with concrete pavement and in other respects in accordance with said Resolution No. 11.

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Righth Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin Street, and from the west line of Broadalbin Street to the east line of Ferry Street, except a strip 36 feet wide, being 18 feet on each side of the center line of Eighth Street and extending the full lengith of the improvement shall be improved as follows:

1st: By grading said portion of said street to the proper sub-grade;

2nd: By paving the roadway of said portion of said street (according to plans and specification) with Portland cenent concrete pavement;

3rd: By laying and constructing pavement headers;

4th: By constructing concrete curbs wherever necessary;

5th; By constructing catch basins and inlets;

6th: By laying vitrified sewer pipes; All in accordance with said Resolution No. 11, and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by Charles H. Leonard, City Engineer, with the Recor-der of said City of Albany on the 27th day of April, 1927.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Eighth Street from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin Street, and from the west line of Broadalbin Street to the east line of Ferry Street, and from the west line of Broadalbin Street to the east line of said Street in said City, in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said Street in said City, in the manner heretofore determined by the owners of the City, and in and by said Resolution No. 11, to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Righth Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$3,148.50.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Eighth Street assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Righth Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by
