

ORDINANCE NO. 1260

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 4 of Ordinance No. 948, entitled "An Ordinance regulating the traffic of vehicles in the City of Albany, and providing a penalty for violation thereof and declaring an emergency," passed by the Council July 9, 1919, and approved by the Mayor July 10, 1919.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 948, entitled "An Ordinance Regulating the Traffic of Vehicles in the City of Albany, and providing a penalty for violation thereof and declaring an emergency," passed by the Council July 9, 1919, and approved by the Mayor July 10, 1919, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows; to-wit;

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person while operating or in charge of a motor vehicle or other vehicle to make a turn to reverse the direction of said vehicle upon any of the streets or alleys within the City of Albany, Oregon, except at street intersections.


