AN ORDINANCE to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined to make in assolution No. 27, adopted by said Council on the 14th day of March, 1928, on Second Street from the east line of Pine Street to the west line of Cleveland Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon; to ascertain, assess, leteraine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said portion of said street that is assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Second Street to be so improved; to authorize and direct the Accorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the docket of City Liens, as provided by the charter of said City; and declaring an emergency:

Leonard, engineer, to compand file in the office of the ecorder of the said City on the 14th day of March, to compile. 1928, plans, specifications and estimates of the probable cost of making the improvement of Second Street from the east line of Pine Street to the west line of Cleveland Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, by grading and gravelling the same; and WHEREAS, said engineer, pursuant to said resolution made plans, specifications and

whereas, said engineer, pursuant to said Resolution made plans, specifications and estimates as directed thereby for the improvement of said Second Street, and filled the same in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 14th day of March, 1928, and WHEREAS, the Council of said City on the 14th day of March, 1928, by Resolution No. 27, duly adopted by said Jouncil, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that the Council proposed to improve Second Street from the east line of Pine Street to the west line of Cleveland Street, in the City of Albany, "regon, in

the manner provided in said resolution No. 27, and
WHRHMAS, and by said Resolution No. 27 the Recorder of said City was duly ordered WHRENAS, and by said resolution No. 27 the Recorder of said City was duly or and directed to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Second Street from the east line of Pine Street to the west line of Cleveland Street, in said City, as provided by the charter and ordinances of said City, and

'WHEHEAS, the necorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council,
did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of Second Street in the manner provided by the said Resolution and the charter and ordinances of said City, and
WHEHEAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 27 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Second Street, to be
paid by the owners of real property adjacent to said portion of said street to be improved as specified in said resolution No. 27 to be the sum of Six Hundred Forty Six

and 25/100 Dollars (\$646.25), and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1274, after due notice of the time and in the manner provided by law, the bid of Geo. R. Weirich for the making of said improvement of said
portion of Second Street was accepted, and the Hayor and decorder of the City of Albany were thereby authorized to enter into a contract with Geo. R. Weirich for the
making of said improvement in accordance with said bid, by grading and gravelling said portion of said street, and in other respects in accordance with said Resolution No. 27.

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Second Street, in the City of Albany, from the east line of Pine Street to the west line of Cleveland Street, shall be improved as follows:

1st: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade;
2nd: By surfacing the roadway of said street 16 feet wide with gravel;
All in accordance with said resolution No. 27, and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by Charles H. Econard, City Engineer, with the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 14th day of March, 1928.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Second Street from the east line of Pine Street to the west line of Cleveland Street, in said City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner heretofore determined by the Council and in and by said Resolution No. 27 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Second Street, is hereby declared to be the sum of \$646.25.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Second Street assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Second Street, to be improved as aforesaid; and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 27, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots, or parts
