

ORDINANCE NO. 1300

AN ORDINANCE to ascertain and determine the probable cost of constructing a lateral sewer, which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by Resolution No. 32, adopted on the 10th day of October, 1928, beginning at a point in the Geary Street trunk sewer on Geary Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, 25 feet southerly from the center line of Salem Road and running thence south 76½° west 650 feet to a point 17 feet distant from the center line of said Salem Road, by laying an 8" sewer pipe; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement that is assessed upon the lots, or parts thereof, or parcels or tracts of land adjacent to said improvement; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of said assessment in the docket of City Liens, as provided by the charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of September, 1927, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring Charles H. Leonard, engineer, to prepare plans and specifications for the construction of a lateral sewer, beginning at a point in the Geary Street trunk sewer on Geary Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, 25 feet southerly from the center line of Salem Road, and running thence south 76½° west 650 feet to a point 17 feet distant from the center line of said Salem Road, and for estimates of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and requiring such plans, specifications and estimates of probable cost to be filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 11th day of October, 1927, and

WHEREAS, said engineer, pursuant to Resolution No. 17, made plans, specifications and estimates, as directed, for the construction of said lateral sewer, and filed the same with the Recorder, as aforesaid, on the 11th day of October, 1927, and

WHEREAS, the Council on the 10th day of October, 1928, by Resolution No. 32, duly adopted by the Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it ~~expedient~~ expedient, and said Council proposed to construct said lateral sewer, as hereinabove directed, and

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said Resolution No. 32 gave due notice of said improvement in the manner provided by the charter of said City, and on the 16th day of November, 1928, pursuant to said notice Slate Construction Co. submitted its bid to the Council for the making of said improvement for the sum of \$873.80, which said bid was received and accepted in and by Ordinance No. 1299, passed by the Council on the 16th day of November, 1928, and approved by the Mayor on the 16th day of November, 1928.

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an 8" vitrified terra cotta sewer shall be constructed, beginning at a point in the Geary Street trunk sewer on Geary Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, 25 feet southerly from the center line of Salem Road and running thence south 76½° west 650 feet to a point 17 feet distant from the center line of said Salem Road, in accordance with Resolution No. 32, and the plans and specifications of said improvement filed by Charles H. Leonard, engineer, in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 11th day of October, 1927.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement in the manner hereinabove determined by the Council, of said City, by Resolution No. 32, and by the bid of said Slate Construction Co. is hereby declared to be the sum of \$887.85, and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the owners of the property adjacent thereto, and particularly benefited thereby, is the sum of \$887.85.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, or parcel or tract of land adjacent thereto, as assessed and determined by the Council, is hereby determined and ascertained to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of said lots, or parts thereof, or parcels or tracts of land, as follows, to-wit:

OREGON ELECTRIC RAILWAY CO.--Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10, in Block 1 in Allen & Hawkins Addition to Albany, Oregon	Cost	\$366.00
J.O. BROWN.--Lots 11, 12 and 13 in Block 1 in Allen & Hawkins' Addition to Albany, Oregon	Cost	173.95
R.K. PAYNE.--Lots 1, 2, 3, in Block 2 in Allen & Hawkins Addition to Albany, Oregon,	Cost	173.95
C.M. and Amanda B. WHSTEROOK.--Beginning at the northwest corner of block 2 in Allen & Hawkins Addition to Albany, Oregon, thence southerly along the west line of said block 134 feet; thence westerly parallel with the south line of Salem Road 100 feet; thence northerly parallel with the west line of said block two in Allen & Hawkins Addition to Albany, Oregon, 134 feet, to the south line of Salem Road; thence easterly 100 feet to the place of beginning.	Cost	173.95

Section 4. That the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessment hereby made and declared by this ordinance, together with the names of the respective owners, of each lot, or part thereof, hereinabove described, in the Docket of City Liens of said City, as provided by the charter of said City.


