

**ORDINANCE NO. 1303**

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Ordinance No. 1023, entitled: "An ordinance providing for the inspection and regulation of dairies, dairy herds, milk plants, creameries, milk stations, and for the licensing and regulating the sale and disposal and distribution of milk and cream in the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof," passed by the Council February 8, 1922 and approved by the Mayor February 9, 1922.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Ordinance 1023, entitled an ordinance providing for the inspection and regulation of dairies, dairy herds, milk plants, creameries, milk stations, and for the licensing and regulating the sale and disposal and distribution of milk and cream in the city of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof, passed by the Council February 8, 1922, and approved by the Mayor February 9th, 1922, be and the same is hereby repealed.
