ORDINANCE NO. 1374

An ordinance to amend Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1372, entitled "An Ordinance to license and regulate persons engaged in the business of operating commercial barbage wagons for hire and providing a penalty for violation hereof," passed by the Council April 12, 1933, and approved by the Hayor April 12, 1933.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That section 3 of Ordinance No. 1372, entitled "An Ordinance to license and regulate persons engaged in the ousiness of parkets and providing a penalty for violation hereof," passed by the Council April 12, 1933 and approved by the Hayor April 12, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That the license fee for operating a commercial garbage wagon for hire in the City of Albany shall be 330.00 per annum per wagon payable quarterly in advance. Upon making apllication therefor and upon payment of the license fee as hereby required the Recorder is hereby authorized to issue a license to such applicant, which license shall be effective until December 31, of the year in which the same is issued. provided the fees therefor are paid to such date, otherwise the license shall expire on the date the license shall become delinquent in making payment of the fees as herein required.
