## ORDINANCE NO. 1393

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of Five Huntred Seventy-three and 85/100 (\$573.35) bollare, to be paid to Hurley's Flumbing Shop in payment of the cost of reroofing the City Hall cuilding of the City of Albany and authorizing the Recorder to draw a warrant against the general fund of said City in payment of the assunt herein appropriated and declaring an emergency.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO OFDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the genueral funds of the City of Albany the sum of Five Hundred Seventy-three and 85/100 (\$573.35) Dollars in payment of the cost of re-roofing the City Hall Building of the City of Albany and the Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver to Hurley's Plumbing Shop the General fund warrant of said City in the amount and for the purnose hereby appropriated.

Section 2. In as much as the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an energency is hereby isolared to exist and this ordinance shall become in immediate force and effect upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
