

ORDINANCE NO. 1412.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, to purchase of Shook Produce Company one International Motor Truck, Model C-30, Chassis No. 3770 for the Street Department of said City and appropriating the sum of \$950.00 in payment of the same and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Albany is hereby authorized to purchase of Shook Produce Company one International Motor Truck, Model C-30, Chassis No. 3770 for the use of the Street Department of said City at and for the agreed price of \$950.00.

Section 2. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Street fund of said City the sum of \$950.00 for the purchase of the motor truck mentioned in Section 1 hereof. When the invoice for said truck shall have been properly presented to and allowed by the Council as a valid claim against the City then the Recorder shall be authorized to make, execute and deliver to the said Shook Produce Company the Street fund warrant of said City in the amount of said claim allowed.

Section 3. Whereas the peace, health and safety of the People of the City of Albany require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
