That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General funds of said City the sum of \$1034.19 in payment of the purchase price of one Dodge Ambulance referred to in Section 1 hereof and when the invoice shall have been properly presented to and allowed by the Council as a valid claim against the wity of Albany the Recorder be authorized to make, execute and deliver to the said Ralston Motor Company the general fund warrant of said City in the amount of said claim allowed byt not to exceed the amount hereby appropriated.

Whereas the peace, health and safety of the people of the vity of Albany require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in fill force and effect upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
