

ORDINANCE NO. 1453

AN ORDINANCE providing for the holding of a special election in the City of Albany on the 13th day of September, 1938 for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said city, for their adaption or rejection, a charter amendment to the Charter of said City, as appears by Resolution No. 31 duly adopted on the 13th day of July, 1938, designating the places for the holding of said special election and appointing the officers thereof.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in the manner provided by law and as hereinafter provided and for the purposes as set forth herein a special election shall be held in the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 13th day of September, 1938, commencing at the hour of 8:00 A.M. and continuing until the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. of said day, (excepting the lunch hour of 1:00 o'clock to 2:00 o'clock).

Section 2. That said special election shall be held, except as herein otherwise provided, in the same manner as general elections in said city are held. The following places are hereby designated as the places for the holding of said election:

- First Ward -----Maple School.
- Second Ward-----Veterans Memorial Building
- Third Ward-----Madison School.

Section 3. The following persons are designated as the Judges and Clerks of the election:

Section 4. That previous to entering upon their duties said Judges and Clerks shall take and subscribe to an oath in the manner and form provided by law. In case any Judge or Clerk shall fail to attend then those present shall elect another to act in his place.

Section 5. The Recorder shall cause notice of said special election to be given by publication thereof in the Greater Oregon, a newspaper of general circulation published within said city, once a week for two successive and consecutive weeks within thirty days next preceeding the date of said election which notice shall state the measure to be voted upon and the places designated for the holding of said election.

Section 6. That at said special election a proposed amendment to the charter of the City of Albany shall be submitted to the legal voters for their adoption or rejection as provided in Resolution # 31 adopted by the Council on the 13th day of July, 1938, said resolution now being on file and of record in the office of the Recorder of said city.

Section 7. The Recorder shall cause to be printed in pamphlet form a true copy of the title and text of the measure to be voted upon together with the number and form in which the same will appear on the official election ballot, as provided in said Resolution # 31 and shall mail a copy to each registered voter in said city whose address he may have not later than five days before the date of the election. Preceeding the copy of the act shall be a statement that the same will be voted upon at the special election to be held on the 13th day of September, 1938.

Section 8. The Recorder shall cause a sufficient number of ballots, sample ballots and election supplies for said election and the City Marshal shall install voting booths and distribute ballot boxes and supplies to the Judges and Clerks of election at said voting places for use at said election.
