ORDINANCE NO. 1467

AN ORDILANCE regulating the operation and movement of bicycles on the streets, alleys and public places of Albany, Oregon, the depositing thereof on sidewalks in said City, making requirements as to the lighting equipment for bicycles, regulating the operators and riders on bicycles, and providing for punishment for the violation of this ordinance, including the impounding of bicycles.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALPANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person shall ride any bicycle upon any street, alley or public place in the City of Albany during the period from a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise, or at any time when fog or other atmospheric conditions render the operation of said bicycles damerous to traffic or to the use of the streets, or it any other time when there is not sufficient light to render clearly discernible any person on a street at a distance of two hundred feet, without having a lighted lamp on the front of said bicycle vis-ible under normal atmospheric conditions from a distance of at least three hundred feet in front of such bicycle, and also a reflector mirror or lamp on the rear of said bicycle exhibiting a red light visible under like conditions from a distance of at least two hundred feet to the rear of such bicycle.

Section 2. No person shall operate or ride on any bicycle upon any street, alley or public place in the city of Albany, Oregon, with two or more persons on the same bicycle.

Section 3. No person, while riding on a bicycle on any street, alley or public place in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall hold on to any other vehicle.

Section 4. No person shall ride any bicycle on any sidewalk in the City of Albany, Oregon, at a place where there is a hard surface pave ent on the street adjacent to the place where said bicycle is so ridden; provided however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to any person regularity engaged in the delivery of newspapers.

Section 5. Pedestrians shall at all times have the right of way on sidewalks over any person riding on the sidewalk while engaged in the regular delivery of newspapers, and every such person so riding on a sidewalk in the City of Albeny while engaged in the regular delivery of newspapers shall exercise extreme caution so as to avoid impact with every pedestrian.

Section 6. Every person riding a bicycle on any street, allay or public place in the city of Albany, Oregon, shall keep said bicycle to the extreme right of the traffic lane, and it shall be unalwful for two or more operators of bicycles to travel abreast on any street, alley or public place in the City of Albany, Oregon, or to operate said bicycle on traffic lares otherwise than in single file.

Section 7. Every person riding a bicycle on any street, alley or public place in the City of Altany, Oregon, shall be subject to all provisions of the laws of the State of Oregon and the ordinances of the City of Albany applicable to the driver of a vehicle, except the provisions thereof which by their very nature can have no application.

Section 8. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to run or engage, or to cause to run or be engated, in any bicycle race on any street, alley or public place within the limits of the City of Altany, Oregon, except under permit from and under the supervision of the Marshal of said City.

Section 9. No person shall leave any bicycle lying or purked on any sidewalk in the City of Albany, any place where the same will interfere with or hinder pedestrian traffic on said sidewalk.

Section 10. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the City Pecorder of Albany, Oregon, be punished by a fire of not more than \$10.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jeil not more than five days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the City Recorder, and in addition thereto the City Recorder of Albany, Oregon, may, either in live of or in addition to such fine and improsonment, prohibit the operation upon the streets, alleys and public places of the City of Albany, Oregon, of the bicycle used in such violation of any provision of this ordinance for a period of not to exceed thirty days, in which event the bicycle so used in such violation shall be impounded with the Marshal of said City and retained by him for the period that the operation is prohibited as aforesaid. Section 11. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict derewith are

hereby repealed.
