## ORDINANCE NO. 1543

A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE to regulate and restrain establishments where positions and/or pool tables are kept for hire and/or where bowling alleys are operated for hire; to provide for the closing of such establishments during certain hours; and to provide a penalty for violations hereof and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unhawful for any person, firm or corporation engaged in operating establishments where billiard and/or pool tables are kept for hire and/or where bowling alleys are operated for hire, to operate or keep such establishments open between the hours of twelve o'clock midnight and six o'clock in the morning of week days and it shall also be unlawful to keep such establishments open on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, except between the hours of one o'clock P.M. and twelve o'clock midnight of such day. It shall be lawful that such establishments as herein described may keep open any portion thereof maintained and kept separate from that portion thereof where billiard or pool tables or bowling alleys are operated at any and all hours of any day except as restricted by State law.

SECTION 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent or prohibit minors from visiting or frequenting or engaging in bowling at places where alleys are operated.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlasful for any person engaged in the operation of a billiard or pool room to allow or permit any minor to visit, loiter around or frequent such place of business or to play at any game therein unless such minor be accompanied by one of his parents or legal guardian.

SECTION 4. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof in the Recorder Court, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not to exceed fifty days.

Section 5. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances heretofore adopted by the Council of the City of Albany which may be found to be in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed.
