A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE providing for the holding of a special election in the City of Albany, Oregon, on August 30, 1944, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said City for their adoption or rejection measures for the annexation of certain territories to said City as appears by Resolution No. 12 adopted by the Council on July 26, 1944, and for the holding of special elections within the territories described in said Resolutions; designating the places for the holding of such special elections, appointing the judges and clerks thereof and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: Section1.

That for the purposes set forth herein and in the manner provided by law and this Ordinance a special election shall be held in the City of Albany, Oregon, on Wednesday, August 30, 1944, commencing at the hour of one o'clock P.M. of said day and continueing until the hour of eight o'clock P.M. of said day.

Section 2. Said election shall be held in the lobby at the Railroad Street entrance to the Senior High School Building in the City of Albany, and the following persons are hereby appointed as Judges and Clerks of the Election Board in said City, namely, Judges: F.E. Vantassel <u>Clerks</u>:Clara Ferry, Pauline Hackleman

Section 3. Before entering upon the duties of their office said Judges and Glerks shall subscribe to the following oath: "I do solemnly swear that I will support the Constitution and laws of

"I do solemnly swear that I will support the Constitution and laws of the United States and of the State of Oregon; that I will perform the duties of Judge (or Clerk as the case may be) of election according to law and to the best of my ability and I will studiously endeavor to prevent fraud, deceit and abuse in conducting the election."

abuse in conducting the election." Any person suthorized to administer oaths or one of the Judges hereby appointed is empowered to administer the oath to the Judges and Clerks of the election.

Section 4. If any Judge or "lerk of the election shall fail to attend and serve, then the remaining members of the Board and other voters present at the opening of the poles may select another person in his or her place.

Section 5. The Recorder of the City of Albany shall give notice of said special election by publication thereof in the Albany Democrat Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed within the City of Albany, Oregon, and within the territory proposed to be annexed once each week for four consecutive weeks and also by posting notices there of in four public places within the City of Albany and four public places within each of the territories described in said Resolution for a like period and in the manner provided in the Charter of the City of Albany.

Section 6. That the Recorder shall cause to be printed and shall supply a sufficient number of ballots and sample ballots, records, supplies, furniture, voting booths and ballot boxes at each of said voting places as provided herein in due time for their use by the Elections Boards and voters at the time of holding the election.

Section 7. That for the purpose of submitting the question of annexation of the several territories described in said Resolution No. 12 to the qualified legal voters of such territories respectively for their adoption or rejection a special election shall be held in each of said territories, to-wit:

TERRITORY NO. I.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Abram Hackleman's D.L.C. Not. 699, and Claim No. 62 in Tp. 11 S.R.3W. of the Will. Mer. in Linn County, Oregon, and running thence Easterly to the North line of what is known as River Street in Burkhart Fark Addition to the City of Albany and running thence Easterly along the North line of said Street to its intersection with the West line of the Anderson Cox D.L.C. extended Northerly, thence South along the West line of said D.L.C. to the South line of Salem road, thence Westerly 30 feet to the West line of the County road commonly known as Brick Yard Road, thence Southerly along the West line of said read to the North line of State Highway No. 20, known as Santiam Highway, thence Northwesterly along the North line of said Highway to the East line of Bryants Addition to the City of Albany, thence South and along the Wast line of St. James Fark Addition to the City of Albany to the Southeast corner of said Addition, thence Westerly along the South line of said Addition to the center line of Geary Street, thence Northerly along the center line of Geary Street to the place of beginning. 350

TERRITORY NO. 2.

Beginning at the intersection of the West line of Ferry Street with the North line of what is commonly known as Fifteenth Street and running thence Easterly along the North line of said Fifteenth Street and following the curves thereof to the Southeast corner of Cak Grove Acres, thence Northwesterly along the East boundary line of said Cak Grove Acres, it being the Western boundary line of a County road, and following the said boundary line of said road to the South line of Ninth Street, thence Westerly along the South line of Ninth Street to the West line of Railroad Street extended, thence in a Southwesterly direction to the Southeast corner of Block 96 in Monteiths Southern Addition, thence Southwesterly along the Eastern boundary line of the Donation Land Claim of Thomas Monteith to a point where the same intersects the South line of Fourteenth Street extended Easterly, thence Westerly along said South boundary line of Fourteenth Street and its extension to the West line of Ferry Street, thence Southerly along the West line of Ferry Street to the place of beginning.

TERRITORY NO. 3.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 6 in Block C in Central Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County. Oregon, thence West along the North line of Fifteenth Street to the West line of the Facific Highway, thence Southwesterly along the West line of said Facific Highway to its intersection with the North line of Seventh Street extended easterly from Schultz Front Addition to the City of Albany, thence Westerly and along the North line of said Seventh street to the West line of the County road, thence Northerly along the West line of said road to a point 11.715 chains Southerly from the South line of Fifteenth Street, thence Westerly and parallel with the South line of Fifteenth Street to the East line of property now owned and occupied by the Bureau of Mines of the United States Government, thence Northerly along the East line of said property to the North line of Fifteenth Street, thence Easterly along the North line of Fifteenth Street to the Southwest corner of Block 9 in Rosement Addition to the G ity of Albany, Oregon, thence Northerly along the West line of said Addition to the South line of Thirteenth Street, thence Easterly along the South line of Thirteenth Street to the West line of Fourteenth Street, thence Southerly along the West line of Vine Street to the North line of Fourteenth Street, thence Easterly along the South line of Fourteenth Street, thence Easterly along the South line of Thirteenth Street to the North line of Fourteenth Street, thence Eastefly along the North line of Fourteenth Street to the Western line of the right of way of the Southern Pacific Railway Company, thence Southerly along said right way line to the place of beginning.

TERRITORY NO. 4.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Block 7 in City View Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence Easterly along the South line of said Block 7 to the Southwest corner of Block 6 in said Addition, thence Southerly and along the West line of Blocks 9, 14 and 17 in said Addition to the Southwest corner of said Block 17, thence Southerly to the Northeast corner of Block 4 in Albany Heights Addition to said City, thence Westerly along the Northern boundary line of said Addition to the East line of Broadway Street, thence Southerly along the East line of Proadway Street to the South line of fifteenth Street, thence West to the West line of Queen Street, thence Southwesterly along the West line of said Queen Street to the Southwest corner of Block 6 in Hazelwood Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, which is the East line of Lincoln Street, thence Northerly along the East line of Lincoln Street to the North line of said Hazelwood Addition, thence Easterly to the West line of Broadway Street, thence Northerly along the West line of Broadway Street to the north line of Ninth Street extended, thence Easterly to the place of beginning.

TERRITORY NO. 5.

All that portion of that certain tract of land known as tract No.l of Bryants Tracts now owned by the City of Albany, Oregon, and commonly known as Bryant's Park and extending the full width thereof to the center of the Willamette River.

Said special elections in said territories shall be held at the same time and in the same manner as provided in this Ordinance for the holding of the special election in the City of Albany, Oregon, as hereinabove designated, and in accordance with the Charter of said City.

That the places within the respective territories hereinabove designated for the holding of such special elections and the names of the Judges and Clerks of elections therein are as follows, to-wit:

Territory 2.

Cameron Lumber Company Office. Judge: Mrs. Roy Dolan. Clerks:Mrs. K. C. Graber, Mrs. J.C. Hooker.

Territory 3.

Fisher Implement Co. Office. Judge: Mrs. Alton Johnson. Clerks:Mrs. J.J. Howard. Elmer E. Curry.

Territory 4.

James Jenks Garage. Judge: Mrs. Walter Daggett. Clerks:D.M. Shreve, Mrs. James W. Jenks.

Section 8. Whereas existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
