

ORDINANCE NO. 1585

A Bill for an Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$367.40 of the General Funds of the City of Albany to pay the cost of installing a concrete sidewalk on the West side of Elm Street between Twelfth Street and Klamath Street, and authorizing the Recorder to execute and deliver a warrant drawn on the General Funds of said City payable to J.W. Baines in said amount.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the General Funds of the City of Albany the sum of \$367.40 for the payment of the installation of a concrete sidewalk on the West side of Elm Street between Twelfth Street and Klamath Street in said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver a General Fund warrant in the sum hereinabove appropriated, payable to J.W. Baines.
