ORDINANCE NO. 1589

A bill for An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with Leonard & Slate for the improvement of Sixth Street from the West line of Jefferson Street to the West line of Madison Street in the City of Albany, Oregon.

Whereas, by Ordinance No. 1707 of the City of Albany, it was ordered that Sixth Street from the West line of Jefferson Street to the West line of Madison Street in said City be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- 1.By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- 2.By surfacing the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with a six inch gravel base and a one inch oil mat surface to be approved by the Council or as an alternate, by surfacing the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with a six inch gravel base and a one inch oil mat surface and by providing for an 18 inch concrete gutter seven inches thick on each side thereof.
- 3.By laying and constructing concrete gutters.
- 4.By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks wherever necessary.
- 5.By installing a proper drainage system on said streets.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans, specifications and estimates of W.W. Larsen, City Engineer, then on file with the Recorder of said City; and

Whereas, it was provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said Ordinance.

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of said City according to law and the ordinance aforesaid, on the 7th day of September, 1944, at a meeting of the Council held on said date Leonard & Slate presented to the Council his bid for making said improvement, which said bid was and is in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which bid the said Leonard & Slate proposed to furnish all material and emplements and to perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the following named prices, to-wit:

Whereas, it has been determined by the Council that said improvement of said portion of said street be made by providing for an 18 inch concrete gutter 7 inches thick on each side of saidstreets as provided in Paragraph 2 in the manner of improving as hereinabove set forth.

Whereas, said Leonard & Slate was the lowest and best bidder for said work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefo.

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO OPDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of Leonard & Salte for said improvement of said portion of Sixth Street be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in writing with the said Leonard & Slate for the making of said improvement on behalf of the City of

Albany, Oregon, and upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract shall provide that the work of said improvement shall commence as soon as weather conditions permit after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embodied in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 31st day of October, 1944, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed after the time stated in said contract unless such time be extended by the Council, and that the said Leonard & Slate — shall furnish a bond in the sum of \$7794.10 to be approved by the Mayor of said City and conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the said Leonard & Slate — and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation arising out of such contract.
