ORDINANCE NO. 1610

A Bill for an ordinance appropriating \$5,775.00 of the general fund of the City of Albany for the purchase of one Seagrave Triple Combination Fumping Engine from Howard-Cooper Corporation, and of 1000 feet $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch Fire Hose from Eureka Fire Hose.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Thereis hereby appropriated \$5,775.00 of the general fund of the City of Albany for the purchase of the following:

- (1) One Seagrave Triple Combination Fumping
 Engine (heretofore authorized by the Council
 on Dec. 6, 1944), \$4,025.00
- (2) 1000 feet of 3½ inch Trojan Fire Hose, (heretofore authorized by the Council on March 8, 1945.), \$1,750.00

the item of \$4,025.00 as above set forth having heretofore been set aside by the Council in a sinking fund for the purchase of Fire Department equipment, and the item of \$1,750.00 as above set forth having heretofore been provided for in the 1944-45 annual budget of the City of Albany.

Section 2. The City Recorder is, therefore, hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to Howard-Cooper Corporation the general fund warrant of said City in the sum of \$1,750.00 to Eureka Fire "oss in payment of the purchase price of the above described item of fire hose.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance, therefore, becomes effective immediately after its final passage and approval.
