## ORDINANCE NO. 1614

A Bill for an ordinance authorizing the Layor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, enter into a contract with D. F. momentie for the improvement of Second Street from the east line of main Street to the west line of fine Street in the City of Albany, Oregon. Oregon, to

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 1607 of the City of albany, regon, it was ordered that the following street in said city be improved, to-wit: Second Street from the east line of Main Street to the west line of rine Street.

Said improvement to be made in the following manner:

by grading said street to the proper sub-grade. By surfacing the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with crushed rock and crushed gravel base and oil mat surface.

 By laying and constructing concrete gutters.
By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks wherever necessary.

By installing a proper drainage system.

and in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimated of Walter W. Farsen, -ngim - eer, then on file in the office of the Ascorder of said City; and

WHERMAS, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of said City of algive notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and said ordinance, and

WHEREAS after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder according to law and the Ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit; on the 16th day of July, 1945, D. s. -chenzie presented to the Council of the Jity of Albany, his bid for making said improvement in the manner aforesaid, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid D. r. Mc-Aenzie proposed to furnish all the material and implements and perform all the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the following named prices, to-wit: Aggregate bid based on engineer's estimates, 44304.40.

AND WHERIAS the said D. F. McKenzie was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid made therefor:

Section 1. That the bid of D. F. Eckenzie for the improvement of Second Street from the east line of Main Street to the west line of Fine Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner as specified in said Ordinance No. 1607, be and the same is hereby accepted and the Layor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in writing with the said D. F. Eckenzie for the making of said improvement on behalf of the City of Albany upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned and in the manner and form provided by law.

Said contract shall provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or befors the first day of September, 1945 unless further time be extended by the Council of said City, and the City of Albany, tregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages in the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day said work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the said D. F. McKenzie shall furnish a bond in the sum of \$2152.20 to be approved by the hayor of the City of Albany, Cregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the said D. r. mcmenzie and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.
