## Ordinance No. 1628

A Bill For: An ordinance to determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of albany, oregon has determined to make in Resolution No. 14 adopted by said Council on the 26 th day of July, 1944 to make on Sixth otreet from the "est line of Jeiferson Street to the Vest line of Ladison Street; to ascertain, assass, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereor adjacint to said part of sald Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WhEREAS, On the 12th day of July, 1944 the Council of the Cit, of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City angineer of said city to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Sixth street from the \%est Ine of efferson 3treet to the West line of liadison Straet in the following manner to-wit:

1. By grading said streets to the proper sub-grade.
2. By surfacine the roadiay of said streets full width with full intersections with a six inch gravel isse and a one inch oil mat surface to be approved by the Council, or as an alternate, by surfacing the roadway of said streets full width with full intersections with a six inch eravel base and a one inch oil mat surface and by providing for an 18 inch concrete gutter seven inches thick on esch sid thereor.
3. By laying and constructing concrete gutters.
4. By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks wherever necessary;
5. By instaliing a proper drainaee system on said streets.
and for the estimates of the work to le done on said portion of said Street end the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be flled in the Fecorder's offics of said City, said Resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No. 11", and adopted the l2th day of July, 1944.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 11 made plans, Specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the inprovement of said Street in the manner specified in said resolution No. 11 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the lath day of July, 1944.

WHEREAS, the Council on the 2oth day of July, 19.4 by hesolution No. 14 duly acopted by said council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve said Street in the manner provided in said fiesolution No. 14; and

VHEREAS, in and by said Resolution No. 14 adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Fecorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said propose: improvement of said street as provided by the Charter of said City; and

WiEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order an direction of the Council of said City of Albany did duly five notice of said proposed improvement of said street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City; and

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 14 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of makinc said improvement of said Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjac-nt to said portion of said street to be improved as specifiod in said Resolution No. 14 to be the sum of $\$ 7,0<4.51$.

THEREFORE
THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBAIV DO ORDAIN AS FOLLONS:
Section 1. That Sixth Street in the City of Albany, Oregon from the East line of Jefferson treet to the Wast line of liadison street be improved as follows;

1. By grading said strests to the proper sub-grade.
2. By surfacing the radaay of said streets full width with full intersections with a six inch gravel base and a one inch oll mat surface to be approved by the Council, or as an alternate by surfacing the roadway of said streets full width with full intersections with a si $x$ inch gravel base and a one inch ofl mat aurface and by providing for an 18 inch concrete gutter seven inches thick on each side thereof.
3. By laying an constructing concrete gutters.
4. By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks wherever necessary.
5. By instaling a proper drainage system on said streets.
all in accordance with sald Resolution No. 14 and the plans and specifications for sald improvement flled by the City Eneineer with the Pecorder of sald Cit


#### Abstract

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Street In the manner heretofore determined by the Council of Albeny in and by Resolution No. 14 to be pald by the owners of tha real property adjacent to said portion of said street is hereby declared to be the sum of $\$ 7,024.51$.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said Improvement of sald Street assessed upon each lot or part the reof adjacent to sald part of said Street to bs improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 14 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
