A BIIL FOR: An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Jefferson Streat from the North line of Hackleman Street to the South line of Fourteenth Street in the City of albany, Oregon, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement if the same shall not be completed on the tima agreed upon, and the divins of a zood and sufficient bond for the falthful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the eivine by the Recorder of said City of notice for bids for the completion of sald improvement.

## THE FEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLYONS:

Section 1. That Jefferson Street from the North line of Hackleman Street to the South line of Fourteenth Street shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

## 1. By grading said street to the proper sub-grade; <br> 2. By surfacing tae roadway of said street with crushe d gravel.

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with tha charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Walter $W$. Larsen, Engineer, for tha improvement of said street filed in theoffice of the Recorder of said City of albany on the 16th day of July, 1945.

The cost of the making of said improvement shall be paid out of the funds to be collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertalned and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said street so to be improved as herainalove described and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the charter of said City of albany.

Said improvement shall be completed by the lst day of November, 1945.
All bids for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonalbe by the Council may be rejected.

Any person, fim or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the makine of said improvament shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of siening such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the layor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to fifty per cent of the amount to be paid under such contract for the faithful performance there of.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation enterine into any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, the City of Al any shall be deemed to suffer darages on account thereof in the amount of $\$ 25.00$ per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doins tha work at the completion thereof unless the time of the completion of sald improvement be extended by tha Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for making of saim improvement by publishine such notice ten days in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a newspaper of ganeral circulation published in the City of albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doine said work of imptoving sald portion of said street.
